DISASTER MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:

As we are aware that working area of SGVS which is three block Sadar, Kaler and Arwal in

Arwal District of Bihar is badly affected with draught and it is a Draught prone area. Here people face major challenges during agriculture and its allied work availability of drinking water is also a major problem in area. Agriculture work here is totally depend on rain and due to low rain fall every year farmers face a lot of problem fight with draught situation simultaneously economical and family problems also break them. in this situation government help is not provided adequately if government help is provided then neutral attitude of govt. officials and middle man interference is not enable needy people for access of help. Hence for solution of these natural disastrous situation SGVS team guide them in sowing of rice and wheat crop by SRI (Systematic Rice Intensification) and (Systematic Wheat Intensification) method and aware them to follow this method which require less water in cultivation of crops additionally in aware programme SGVS also focus on water born disease and how Grain Bank (Grain is Bank Formed By Community under guidance of SGVS From Where People Can Take Grain As Loan In Hunger Situation And Return With Additional Grain When They Have) help them during draught and SGVS learn them to adopt method to make house which will not destroy during earth quake.

These are the important points in SGVS priority for which Awareness Programme was organized during the year 2012-13

WATER SANITATION AND HYEGEINE PROGRAMME



Poverty, illiteracy and lack of facilities are the factors in which lots of work is to be done for majority of our target group in context of Water, Sanitation and hygiene. For this any kind and level of work is incipient without priority on water, sanitation and hygiene which cannot be evaluated. For this programme we (SGVS) have select Dalit, lower class, Scheduled cast especially Mushahar community in Arwal block of Arwal District in Bihar. There is major issue of improvement in sanitation and hygiene among Mushahar community because they are not aware on sanitation and hygiene they live in dirty atmosphere in surroundings and they keep pig as pet who like to live in garbage and drains and create a great threat to spread disease in Mushhars community.

SGVS work for awareness among mushahar community on priority basis for sanitation and hygiene and programme was focused to change in style and attitude with proper follow up way to keep sanitation and hygiene with them. Our aim was to improve sanitation in their surroundings because they were living with PIG and mushahar community are sensitive to severe infected disease like Jaundice, Malaria, Kalazar, encephalitis and other contaminated disease. 90% cases of Kalazar is found in mushhar community and they live in atmosphere where mosquitoes breed and spread Malaria. Open defecation is common with this community though government under Complete Sanitation Campaign implement all effort to disseminate use of toilet to avoid infections and ensure a complete hygienic atmosphere. Government has focused to aware them on Sanitation and hygiene. We have given our full effort to change of their attitude but due to poverty, illiteracy and lack of facilities are the factors which create obstacles in complete success of our programme of change.

Outcome:

- ✚ Our target group becomes aware on Sanitation and hygiene. There is mark attitude changing in use of drinking water they are keeping full attention to use safe drinking water.
- ✚ Change in attitude and habit to avoid open defecation increase in target group and they are understanding importance of safe defecation in side toilet
- ✚ People become aware to wash hand after toilet and before taking meal
- ✚ Mushhar community people become aware on inhibition of disease spread and trying to keep disease away.

PROGRAMME ON HUMAN RIGHT



Human right is basic and fundamental right of a man but its violation cases are occurring in world. In Indian constitution human right is clearly mention which is for human protection but due to lack of its knowledge and awareness govt officials, police and administrative peoples is freely violating human right. Lack of knowledge and access even judiciary is also not more helpful even person who violate human right they don't know that they are breaking this right and what will its impact? Human Right Committee is formed whose function is to collect information of human right violation and to take right and necessary step to stop violation of human rights._During year 2012-13 SGVS organized following work on human right

- ✚ Village level awareness programme on human right
- ✚ Block level meeting in Arwal and Kaler block with community leaders on human right
- ✚ Interface & Discussion on human right with Panchayat member(PRI), administrative officers and intellectuals
- ✚ To linked community people with different govt. agencies and stakeholders.
- ✚ Dissemination of human right information and knowledge among community people and aware them to protect human right and take necessary step against people who violate human right

WOMEN RIGHT



Women are sharing approx 49% that is near to half of population and they are with special characteristics of reproduction so that without women it is out of imagination to maintain population balance. Women is in form of mother, sister, Daughter and idol of sacrifice but in this male dominant society in right matter she is

treated as second class and are inhibited by out of access of rights. There is clear discrimination with women on the basis of sex, Girl child sex selected abortion, lack of opportunity and prospect to come ahead, Discrimination with boy and girl in family and society are the factors which is responsible for keeping them at the verge of backward situation in education, social, economical and political sphere.

SGVS PROGRAMME ON WOMEN RIGHT

- ✚ People's sensitization on women right and Village level awareness programme on women right in which PRI Elected Women Representative (EWR) will included so that they will also sensitize on women right and will involve in women right protection.
- ✚ To promote women empowerment programs
- ✚ To form women Self Help Group (SHG) and keep them functional.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON TRAFFIKING



It was observed that due to poverty, scarcity and illiteracy cases of human trafficking was increased in SGVS target group and operational area.

Somebody were involve in this trade who capture innocent and illiterate community women and girls and give temptation of work or marriage of poor girls and get benefit of their compulsion and innocancy some people in community or known to community people are working as broker and they arrange all these plot. Some women and girl come in their grip and without consent of family members they go with them and spoil own life broker sell them and they are either treated as slave in house or used as sex worker or become a prostitute in any brothels. Low level status of women's and girls' in area is identified and measured as an important reason behind flourish of child and girl trafficking. So that it is essential to unite and aware the community people and alert women and girls to avoid any temptation or any other means which are risky in their vision so that trafficking should not flourish.

PROGRAMME OUTCOME

- ✚ Extensive awareness programme run on human trafficking on village level
- ✚ Peoples in this target group has increase their understanding on this issue and enhance attempt to stop trafficking
- ✚ Women's and girls understanding develop that they are not any ornamental things and they are preparing them self for protection
